Are you currently suffering from symptoms of a urinary tract infection (UTI)?

If you are a female aged 16-64 and suffering from symptoms of a UTI, there's a new pharmacy service that could help you.

The symptoms include:

Pain passing urine

Needing to pass urine at night more than usual

Visible cloudy colour when passing urine

The pharmacist at your local community pharmacy* can now assess you and, if appropriate, provide an antibiotic to treat the infection.

**This means you may not need to see your G.P.
